Recipe: Fresh Strawberry Scones

Ingredients (Serves 4)

- 115g self-raising wholemeal flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- ▼ 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 25g sunflower spread
- 15g caster sugar
- 70g hulled fresh strawberries, chopped
- About 4 tablespoons skimmed milk, plus a little extra for glazing

Method:

- **1.** Preheat oven to 220°C/fan 200°C/gas mark 7. Lightly flour a non-stick baking sheet; set aside. Combine flour, baking powder and cinnamon in a bowl; rub in sunflower spread until mixture resembles breadcrumbs.
- 2. Stir in sugar, strawberries and enough milk to form a soft dough. Lightly knead dough on lightly floured surface. Divide into 4 equal portions; shape each one into a roughly 6cm (2 1/2 in) in diameter. Place on baking sheet; brush tops with milk to glaze.
- 3. Bake for 10-12 minutes. Transfer to a wire rack to cool. Serve scones warm or cold, split and spread with a little strawberry jam and top with fresh strawberry slices.
