What is Help BEAT Heart Disease?

It's part of Research for the Future – an NHS supported campaign to encourage people to get involved in health research. If you have a heart condition, such as angina, atrial fibrillation or heart failure, find out about research going on in your local area by joining Research for the Future. Better care and treatments are only possible through research. Together we could Help BEAT Heart Disease.

What does it involve?

Joining Research for the Future is free. When you sign up, we will ask you for your contact details, heart condition and whether you have a family history of heart disease.

We will explain the different types of research available and you can tell us which of these you are interested in. We then use this information to tell you about studies going on in your area and how to get involved.

There are lots of opportunities from simple questionnaires to taking part in trials of new treatments. It is always your decision whether you take part in any research you receive information about.

Your participation is voluntary. You can withdraw from a study or the Research for the Future database at any time without it affecting your care.
